





Harv Hartman - **George B. Carlisle** **Distinguished Service Award**

Few have left a legacy as enduring as Harv Hartman, a man whose dedication to public service, education, and community has shaped Clear Creek ISD for generations. A Nebraska native and proud University of Nebraska graduate, Harv came to the Clear Lake area in 1966, drawn by the excitement of the U.S. space program. Over a remarkable 33-year career at NASA, he contributed to historic missions including Apollo, Skylab, Space Shuttle, and the International Space Station, ultimately serving as Director of Human Resources. Along the way, he earned NASA's highest honors, including the Distinguished Service Medal, Outstanding Leadership Medal, and Exceptional Service Medal.

But Harv's impact extends far beyond the space program. As a longtime volunteer and visionary leader in the Clear Creek Education Foundation, he served as a board member and chairman, helping shape the Foundation's mission to support students and educators. It was Harv's admiration for legendary educator George Carlisle that inspired him to establish this very award—recognizing extraordinary individuals who may not be CCISD alumni, but whose contributions have profoundly strengthened the district. Tonight, fittingly, Harv joins the ranks of those he once helped honor.

His community service is as vast as his professional accomplishments. Harv has held leadership roles with the Bay Area Houston Economic Partnership, Krist Samaritan Center, Space Center Houston, YMCA, and numerous faith-based initiatives at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church. His commitment has been recognized with accolades such as the 2015 CCISD Citizen of the Year Award and Bay Area Turning Point's Men and Women of Heart Award.

Harv and his wife, Carolyn, built their lives in the Clear Lake area, raising two sons—Scott and John, both Clear Lake High School graduates—and celebrating the next generation of family milestones with their grandsons, Nicholas and Alex.

Reflecting on this honor, Harv shares, “During my time on the CCEF board, we created this award to honor people like George Carlisle, who shaped CCISD with dedication and vision. To now receive the award that bears his name is humbling beyond words. The Clear Creek Education Foundation will always have a special place in my heart.”



Shari Sweeney - Alumni Impact Award

A proud Clear Lake High School graduate, Class of 1987, Shari Liebman Sweeney has dedicated her career and community service to enhancing the Clear Lake area and supporting Clear Creek ISD. Born in Denver, Colorado, and raised in Clear Lake since infancy, Shari embodies the spirit of lifelong commitment to her community.

After earning a Bachelor of Arts in Communications from the University of Houston–Clear Lake, Shari began her professional journey with the Clear Lake Area Chamber of Commerce in 1992. Over the past three decades, she has risen through the organization, currently serving as Vice President. In this role, she coordinates major community events, works closely with local government and educational partners, and continues to advocate for initiatives that strengthen education and workforce development. She furthered her expertise in nonprofit leadership by completing the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Institute for Organization Management at the University of Arizona in 2014.

Beyond her professional achievements, Shari has been an unwavering volunteer and mentor. She dedicated over twenty years to leading a local youth dance and cheer team, mentored Clear Lake High School seniors, and has actively supported the Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo Go Texan Style Show for nearly three decades. She also served on numerous Clear Lake High School Booster Club boards and contributed her insight to the CCISD Facilities Advisory Committee.

Shari's family roots run deep in Clear Creek ISD. Her parents, Ed and Harriet Liebman, instilled a love for education and community—Harriet served over twenty years in the Clear Lake High School library. Shari and her husband, Don, also a proud Falcon, raised two Clear Lake High School graduates, Sloan (Class of 2017) and Donovan (Class of 2020).

For Shari, receiving the Alumni Impact Award is a deeply humbling honor. She shares, “Being recognized in this way is truly meaningful, as it reflects not just my journey but the collective dedication and support of the people who have shaped and inspired me. I’m proud to be part of the Clear Lake legacy and to continue advocating for the excellence of Clear Creek ISD.”



Kevin Kiersh - Dennis Johnson Memorial Small Business Award

Kevin Kiersh, co-owner of Red River Restaurants, embodies the heart and soul of small business leadership in our community. Since opening their first restaurant in League City in 2002, Kevin and his brother Ric have built more than a dining destination—they've created a gathering place defined by authentic, wood-fired barbecue, made-from-scratch meals, and genuine hospitality.

Born in Houston and a proud graduate of Sealy High School, Class of 1998, Kevin moved to League City over 23 years ago with a vision to open Red River. Together with his wife, Dana, Kevin has raised three children—Kamryn, Kellen, and Claire—who are all part of the Clear Creek ISD family. His restaurants have not only fed the community but have nourished its spirit, generously supporting local schools, teachers, students, and countless community initiatives. Whether it's sponsoring events, feeding educators, or lending a hand to local causes, Kevin has always shown up for CCISD.

Beyond his business, Kevin also contributed his time and expertise to the City of League City's COVID Task Force, ensuring the well-being of local residents during challenging times.

Reflecting on this recognition, Kevin shares, "Giving back to the community that has given us so much means the world to us. It's been an honor to support the schools, families, and programs that make this area such a special place to call home.



Colonel Stuart Glenn - Valor Award

Colonel Stuart W. Glenn's distinguished military career and community leadership embody the highest ideals of service, leadership, and valor. A graduate of Texas A&M University, he commissioned in the U.S. Marine Corps in 1999 and soon served as a platoon commander with 2nd Battalion, 3rd Marines—deploying twice to Okinawa, Japan—and later leading security detachments in the Middle East under CTF-53.

By 2007, he advanced to commanding a rifle company with 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines, deploying to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom; three years later he served as Maritime Raid Force Commander with the 31st Marine Expeditionary Unit. He has deployed on missions throughout the globe—including parts of Africa, the Middle East, and the Indo-Pacific.

In 2019, as commander of 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines, Col. Glenn led his battalion during Operation Inherent Resolve to defeat ISIS across Syria and Iraq, coordinating missions in six countries within a high-stakes, multinational environment. In 2023, he assumed command of the 13th Marine Expeditionary Unit, now serving as the forward-deployed Marine Rotational Force—Southeast Asia in support of regional exercises and interoperability initiatives throughout Southeast Asia.

Colonel Glenn's service has been recognized with top military accolades including the Legion of Merit and other honors for his strategic leadership and operational excellence (as noted during the 13th MEU change-of-command ceremony). He has also shaped the future of the Corps, serving as Marine Officer Instructor at Texas A&M and later advising Royal Saudi Marines and Special Forces units on tactics, doctrine, and strategy.

Col. Glenn continues to serve our country and is currently at the Pentagon coordinating Marine Corps service wide actions and policy as the Corps' Secretary of the General Staff. Additionally, he maintains ties to the community: supporting veteran and military family programs, mentoring students in leadership initiatives, and participating in school and civic events to inspire future public servants.

Colonel Glenn's legacy is one of sustained courage—beyond battlefields, it's lived through mentorship, engagement, and consistent commitment to service.

Reflecting on the honor, he says: "Valor is not about medals or recognition. It's about responsibility—standing up when it matters most, for your fellow soldiers, your community, and for those who come after you. I accept this award on behalf of all who serve and sacrifice every day."



Dr. Peter Wuenschel - CCISD Citizen of the Year Award

For nearly three decades, Dr. Peter Wuenschel has been a steadfast advocate for students and families across the Clear Creek ISD community. A native of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Peter's path led him to Houston for graduate school, where he discovered a calling that would shape the lives of countless young people.

Dr. Wuenschel holds a Bachelor of Arts in Religion and Sociology from the University of Tulsa, a Master of Social Work, and a PhD in Social Work from the University of Houston. Since 1996, he has served as the Executive Director of Communities In Schools – Bay Area, dedicating his career to ensuring that every student has the resources and support needed to succeed. Through his leadership, CIS-Bay Area has partnered with CCISD and the surrounding community to remove barriers to education and build brighter futures.

In addition to his professional work, Dr. Wuenschel has volunteered tirelessly, serving as Education Division Chair for the Clear Lake Area Chamber of Commerce, a member of the Bay Area Houston Economic Partnership, and on various chambers of commerce boards. His efforts have been recognized with previous honors, including the 2010 CCISD Citizen of the Year Award and the 2014 Adjunct Professor of the Year Award from the University of Houston–Clear Lake.

Peter and his wife, Debbie, moved to the Houston area in 1991, raising four children—Diedra, Jeremiah, Matthew, and Erica—and are now proud grandparents to eight, soon to be nine, grandchildren. A fraternal twin and one of six children, Peter grew up in a family lovingly known as “The Singing Wuenschels,” performing across the U.S. and Canada at youth conferences.

Reflecting on this honor, Dr. Wuenschel shares, “Being named the 2025 CCISD Citizen of the Year is deeply meaningful. It reflects the power of community partnerships and a shared belief that every child deserves the opportunity to succeed. This recognition belongs to all who believe, as I do, that education is the foundation of a better future.”




